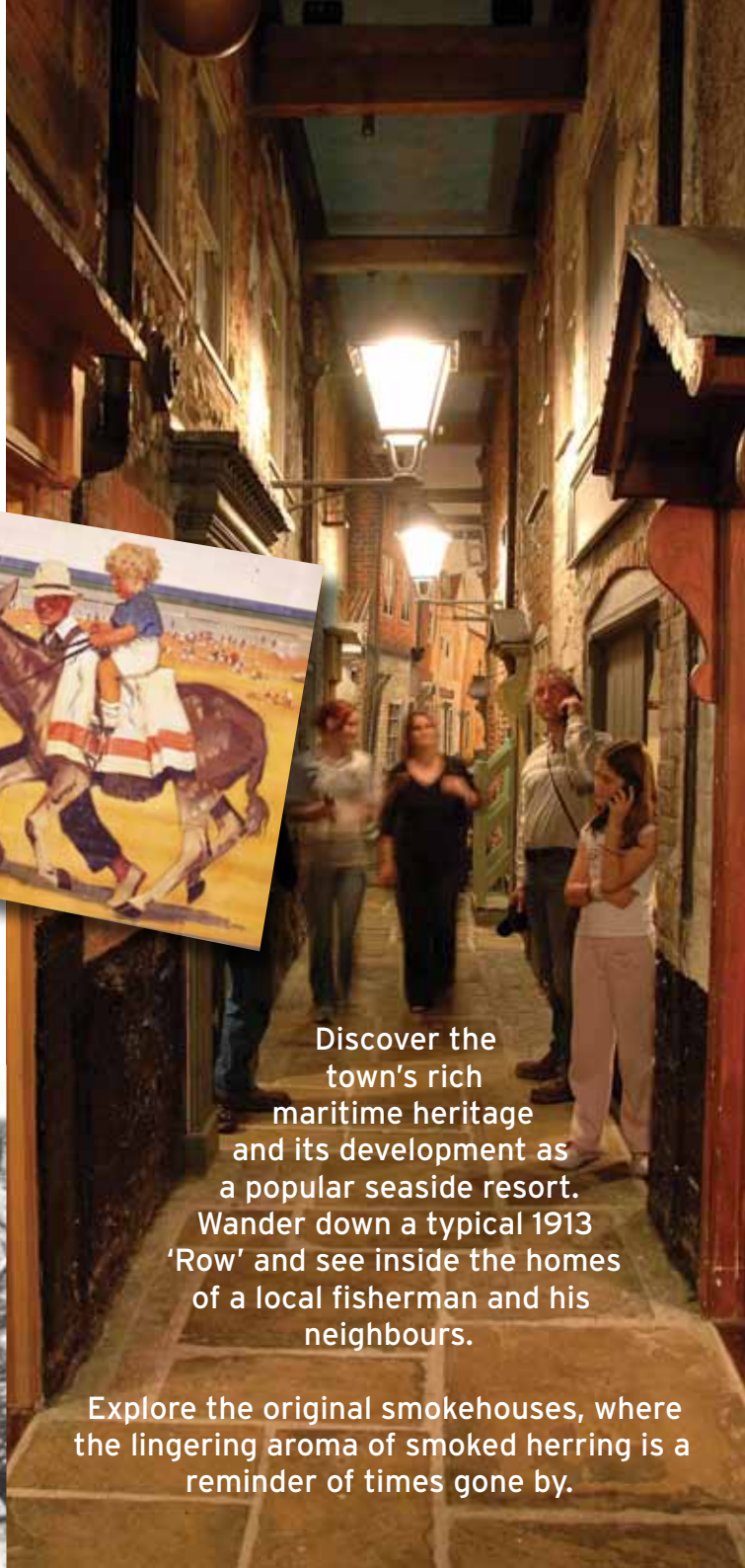
Time & Tide

Museum of Great Yarmouth Life



Set in one of the UK's best preserved Victorian herring curing works, Time and Tide tells the story of Great Yarmouth from its Ice Age origins to the present day.

Experience the heady atmosphere of a 1950s fish wharf and take the wheel of a steam drifter. Hear gripping tales of wreck and rescue and meet some of the colourful characters who made their living from the sea.



Discover the town's rich maritime heritage and its development as a popular seaside resort. Wander down a typical 1913 'Row' and see inside the homes of a local fisherman and his neighbours.

Explore the original smokehouses, where the lingering aroma of smoked herring is a reminder of times gone by.



Enjoy fascinating archive film shows and hands on displays. Relax in the attractive courtyard beneath a canopy of sails.

Meander through the displays having fun with the interactive games and use an audio guide to delve deeper into the town's history.

Visit our Other Museums in Great Yarmouth

When you buy a ticket for Time and Tide you will receive a discount voucher saving you money when you visit these museums.

The Tolhouse

Tolhouse Street just off South Quay

Visit one of the UK's oldest gaols, dating back to the 12th century. See the original cells and discover the fate of the thieves, smugglers, witches, pirates and murderers who were confined here. Use the free audio guide to hear the gaoler and his prisoners describe their experiences.



Saturday 29 October 5 - 7pm

Tolhouse Halloween Night

Visit Great Yarmouth's oldest civic building to experience a genuinely spooky atmosphere and meet Solomon Allies, the Victorian gaoler to hear his chilling local tales.

Elizabethan House

4 South Quay

Stroll around the period rooms in this Tudor merchant's house with a free audio tour. Discover the hoard of Civil War coins and try on Tudor costumes. Experience Victorian life 'upstairs and downstairs' and see what it was like to work in the kitchen and scullery. Decide for yourself whether the plot to execute Charles I was hatched in the 'conspiracy room'. Younger visitors will love the activity packed toy room.
