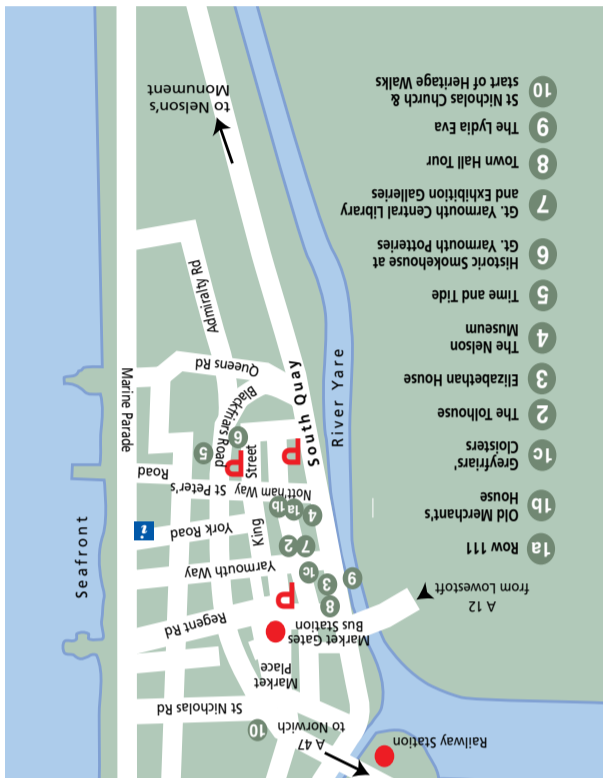

Great Yarmouth Heritage

Great Yarmouth is home to a wealth of museums and period properties that bring the past alive.



Returning to the quay, **The Nelson Museum** explores the life and times of England's most celebrated naval hero, Horatio Nelson.

Wander through the atmospheric period rooms in the **Elizabethan House** once the home of a Tudor merchant.

Housed in a Victorian herring curing works, **Time and Tide Museum of Great Yarmouth Life** is only a short walk away.

Lydia Eva, the last remaining steam herring drifter, is moored on the quayside. Step aboard to see the great



steam engine and to learn more about this historic boat.



Explore the remains of



Greyfriars' Cloisters, a 13th century Franciscan friary. Just off the quayside, you'll find the

This award-winning museum traces the town's rich maritime heritage.

There's a large section of the medieval **Town Wall** with a magnificent flinted turret right near the entrance to the museum.

Tolhouse, one of the UK's oldest gaols dating from the 12th century.



Close by are two special and vividly presented **Great Yarmouth Row Houses: Row 111** set in the 1940s and the **Old Merchant's House** set in the 1870s. Discover how centuries of tenants lived, from wealthy merchants to tenement families and where



In fascinating premises nestled against the 700 year old wall, is the **Historic Smokehouse at Great Yarmouth Potteries**, with local handmade crafts and hands on classes.

Walk on to **Nelson's Monument**, a Grade 1 listed
